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Semengoh Orangutan Resesrve, & Ng Sumpa & Jambu Longhouses a brief peek into longhouse life, moderate comfort level



Date: 24 April 2017 SARAWAK WILDLIFE & NATIVES TOUR: Nanga Sumpa & Jambu Longhouses / sleep on beds in our guest house and eat meals in the guest house. Only visit the longhouses briefly. Price: RM2510. per person

Day 1 Arrival Kuching - Orangutans - Ng Sumpa Longhouse (L,D) Pick up from airport 8AM and transfer to Semenggoh Orang Utan Centre situated about ½ hour drive from Kuching. (*Feeding time is either morning or mid-afternoon. Semengoh visit depends upon your arrival time and may need to be made upon departure instead of arrival*) The orang utans are being nurtured to readapt themselves to the jungle life. You will have the chance to observe the Semi-Wild Orang Utans coming out of the forest for the feeding time. Before arriving at the feeding platform, you will have a brief experience walking through the amazing untouched rainforest.



Depart from Semengoh by air-conditioned van for Batang Ai reservoir. Then journey overland (about 4 hours, depending upon traffic) through rural Sarawak, passing through pepper gardens, cocoa and rubber plantations.

Enroute, a few stops will be made. Visit the colorful native market in Serian town where a variety



of jungle produce such as edible ferns, bamboo shoots and unusual tropical fruit are on display.

Visit a pepper garden and stop by to view wild orchids and several species of carnivorous pitcher plants endemic to Borneo. Lunch en-route.

Then continue your journey, arriving at Batang Ai Lake around 1330-1400 hours. Board a longboat and travel upriver to Nanga Sumpa, arriving at approx. 1530 hours, although the exact time will depend on river conditions. Settle in at our jungle lodge and have dinner. Evening free at leisure. Overnight in our guest lodge.

Day 2: Enseluai Waterfall – Jambu Longhouse - Nanga Sumpa

Following breakfast hike the jungle trails along the river. Then continue upriver by longboat. Our destination is the scenic Enseluai waterfall. Along the way (if conditions are suitable) your boatman may stop to demonstrate fishing Iban-style using a jala or throw net.

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Visit Jambu longhouse, which is located approximately 30 minutes upriver from Nanga Sumpa.

Jambu is a relatively small community with 8 families. It is the furthermost and most isolated community on the Delok River. After visiting Jambu continue your journey upriver.

Arrive at the waterfall and have time to relax,

swim and enjoy the rainforest surroundings. Enjoy a riverside BBQ lunch prepared by your Iban hosts. Return to the lodge. Dinner and overnight at Nanga Sumpa guest lodge (Forest Lodge pictured below)



Day 3 Nanga Sumpa Lodge – Kuching (B,L) Breakfast in the lodge. Then free at leisure to relax before retracing your trip back to Kuching. Return to your hotel for overnight.



Day 4: Departure ..or take the Kuching City Tour (B) Transfer to airport for your return flight.
